We, the coaches of Cardinal Mooney High School, believe it is right and proper to put in writing and distribute among the players conduct that is expected of the young men and women who participate in the Athletic Program. We feel that you represent more than yourself. You represent the team, the school, the coaches, the faculty and staff of Cardinal Mooney High School. We believe, as a result, that your conduct and appearance should be exceptional. With this in mind, we have formulated the following guidelines:

ATHLETIC POLICIES

Training Rules:

Use of Tobacco products, drinking alcoholic beverages, and taking drugs not prescribed by a physician are prohibited. First offense violations will incur suspension from the next game. The second offense will constitute dismissal from the team for the remainder of the season.

Elastic Clause:

Every situation is different and will be dealt with on an individual basis by school administration. Coaches and the Athletic Director will document all occurrences.

Team Rules:

- a. Team members travel to and from a game in a vehicle with at least one parent, faculty member, or coach if the game is an away game. Verbal or written permission from parents is required in an exception.
- b. Team members travel to and from away games in the school uniform in the complete team uniform or in dress clothes as prescribed by the coach. The same attire holds for home games.
- c. An athlete who tries out for a team is appointed to varsity or junior varsity status, depending on the decision of the coach. The athlete must be willing to change status if the coach deems the change advantageous for the team or for the individual athlete's development.
- d. An athlete must be present for the **entire school day** on the day of a game in order to be eligible to play that day. **Attendance as specified here also holds for eligibility to practice.** Unavoidable appointments or other complications may be considered as exceptions at the discretion of the Principal and the Athletic Director.
- e. Once an athlete remains on the roster of a team through the second game of the season, the athlete is a permanent member of the team. If suspended or having left the team for any reason, the athlete may not participate in another sport until the end of the season of the team left.
- f. Students with an excessive amount (five or more) of outstanding detentions may not participate in athletic activities.
- g. Each coach is responsible for any hair and dress code regulations and their enforcement when these demand more than the school code.
- h. Matters pertaining to the playing of a sport are to be settled between the team and the coach. The Athletic Director and the Principal may be consulted in serious matters or cases.
- i. An athlete must be a member in good standing until the last day of competition, including tournament play, to be eligible for any awards.
- j. No visible tattoos.

Additional regulations of the F.H.S.A.A. are in effect for all athletes.

Cardinal Mooney requires every athlete to have a "Preparticipation Physical Evaluation" completed and dated after May 1, 2011 on file in the Athletic Director's office to be eligible to participate in pre/regular season workouts. Forms may be obtained in the Athletic Department.
