### **Last Week's Highlights:**

#### **Boys Golf**

The boys golf team remains undefeated after beating both Venice and SMA last week. The team was led again by Dalton Plattner who shot a season best 34, as well as Kyle Jarrett, Robbie Higgins and Noah Kumar . The Golf team is 10-0 going into Tournament Play.

## **Swimming**

The Mooney Swimmers competed in the County Championship Meet last Wednesday. Senior Jillian Santiago is the new county champion in the 50 and 100 freestyle events. On the boys side, Callum Grobler finished 3rd in the 100 breast stroke. On Saturday the swimmers competed in the Tri County Championship Meet where 19 teams and over 500 swimmers participated. The Mooney Girls team finished in 8th overall. The 200 Medley Relay team of Jillian Santiago, Katherine Pepe, Cogan Brooks and Cameron Ward finished 8th with their season best time. Also finishing Top 8 individually were Jillian Santiago who took 2nd in the 200 freestyle and 4th in the 500 freestyle and Katherine Pepe who finished 6th in the 100 breaststroke.

## **Volleyball**

Last week the Volleyball team beat Academy of the Holy Names 3-0. The team was led by Kali Plattner, Adrienne Boynes, Dalton Judge and Anna Klemeyer.
