Cross Country

Last Thursday, the Cougar Cross Country runners competed in the Tri-County Championships. The boy's team had strong performances from seniors Sebastian Lescano and Alec Stettler along with freshman Sam Hall and sophomore Ethan Hudson. The girl's team was led by junior Tristan Shipe and seniors Shaylee Crager and Melanie Meegan. Freshman Mackenzie Henderson and sophomore Olivia Givens also had outstanding race finishes.

Volleyball

On Monday night, the Mooney Volleyball team defeated Cypress Creek 3-0 (25-12, 25-4, 25-10) in the first round of District play. The team was led by **Kali Plattner** 12 kills, 6 digs, 3 aces, 1 block, **Anna Klemeyer** 9 kills, **Dalton Judge** 8 kills, 2 blocks and **Lauren Johnson** 7 digs, 3 aces, 25 service points. The team now advances to play Academy of the Holy Names tonight (Tue 10/17) at Tampa Catholic. The Cougar's record is 18-7.
