Navigating the Post-Secondary Process – What you Need to Know – Informational Workshop for the Class of 2022

Mrs. LaFemina will be hosting a workshop for juniors and their families to learn about the time line and tools needed to prepare for all post-secondary opportunities. This is an on campus event and registration is required to attend. Attendance is limited to a junior student and there is a 1 parent maximum. Free Drivers Ed Classes through Ault's Driver Education Center, 941-355-4202. For students age 15 and older who have or are in the process of getting a Florida learner's license and are currently registered high schools students in Sarasota County. This course consists of 6 hours of classroom instruction and 6 hours of behind-the-wheel driving instruction. Classes are offered at various Sarasota County High Schools on various dates. Registration deadline is January 20, 2021. Pick up registration forms in the guidance office. Forms must be dropped off at the school site selected for the drivers ed course.

Tickets for our home soccer games will be available for purchase on the night of the event at the gate. Tickets are \$5, and at this time, Family Passes are not available for purchase.






Please remind your student to be diligent in wearing their mask and social distancing.
