Shoes

2nd offense - \$5.00 for temporary

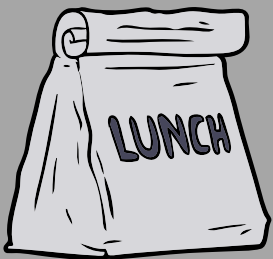
3rd offense - \$10.00 for replacement

Parking Permits



- Parking Passes will be sold during lunch August 16 - 20.
- Be sure to know the make, model, and license plate of the car(s) you drive.
- The cost is \$20 per parking pass.
- There are NO assigned parking spots.
- Be courteous to those around your vehicle, and remember to drive cautiously.

Lunch



- All students must remain on campus during lunch.
- There are two lunch periods.
- Students can pack lunch or pay cash for a grab-and-go lunch.
- Lunches can not be dropped off.
- Lunch menus are posted daily in the Selby Center and are also listed in weekly Cougar News.

Attendance

- Regular and punctual attendance is expected for each school day.
- Students must be in their first period class when the bell rings (7:55 am M,Tu, Th, Fr and 9:27 am Wednesday.)
- Tardy students must receive a pass from the front office.
- If a student is late to school or will be absent that day, call the attendance line at 941-487-2500.
- Anytime a student leaves campus prior to dismissal, he/she must sign out at the front office and have a written note from a parent/guardian.
- Absence notes must be submitted to Mrs. Garlock in the front office upon return.
