

*Please note that Friday, February 4th will be a ½ day of school. Students will be dismissed at 12 noon





EVERYDAY REMINDERS

Attendance

<u>Please ONLY use Attendance@cmhs-sarasota.org</u> to submit notes digitally. ALL absences still need to be called into the Attendance Hotline 941-487-2500.

Anytime your student is out of school, needs to be dismissed early, or comes to school late, a note is required. We ask that all notes for early dismissal be sent first thing in the morning or dropped off at the Front Office. This will help avoid a delay in dismissal and/or an interruption to your student's class.

Please understand that a note is required every time a student arrives late, leaves early, or is absent.
