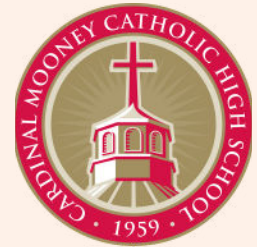

It's Re-Enrollment Time!

Re-enrollment is open and should be completed by March 4, 2022. After this date, transfer applicants will be considered for any openings.

One of our goals is to help you afford a Catholic education. If you need financial assistance, we encourage you to complete the FACTS Grant and Aid application available on the FACTS website <https://Online.factsmgt.com/aid>. Assistance is available on a first-come, first-served basis and must be applied for each year.

Directions to Re-Enroll:

- Please go to www.factsmgt.com
- Select Parent Log In from the menu bar and FACTS Family Portal (ParentsWeb) from the drop-down menu.
- Type in your District Code: CMHS-FL
- Type in your username and password. (If you have forgotten your username or password, please click on the link provided.)
- After logging in, click on Apply/Enroll in the left menu.
- Click on the Enrollment/Reenrollment link.
- Click here to Open Enrollment
- Start Enrollment Packet

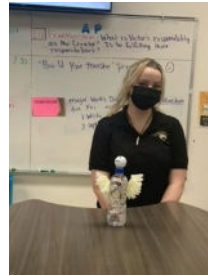
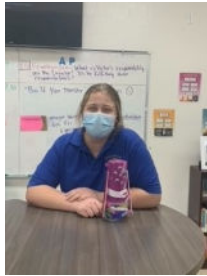

**ALL absences still need to be called into the Attendance Hotline
941-487-2500.**

Anytime your student is out of school, needs to be dismissed early, or comes to school late, a note is required. We ask that all notes for early dismissal be sent first thing in the morning or dropped off at the Front Office. This will help avoid a delay in dismissal and/or an interruption to your student's class.
