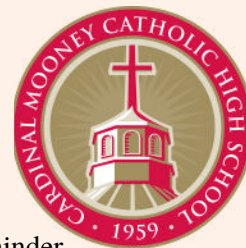

- Please go to www.factsmgt.com
- Select Parent Log In from the menu bar and FACTS Family Portal (ParentsWeb) from the drop-down menu.
- Type in your District Code: CMHS-FL
- Type in your username and password. (If you have forgotten your username or password, please click on the link provided.)
- After logging in, click on Apply/Enroll in the left menu.
- Click on the Enrollment/Reenrollment link.
- Click here to Open Enrollment

Attendance Guide Refresher!

ALL absences need to be called into the [Attendance Hotline 941-487-2500](tel:941-487-2500).

Please make sure you tell us the student's name.

Please *ONLY* use Attendance@cmhs-sarasota.org to submit absence notes. Copy, paste, and save this email address!

Of course, paper notes are welcome too.

Q: When do I need to send in a note?

A: Anytime your student is out of school, needs to be dismissed early, or comes to school late

We ask that all notes for early dismissal be sent first thing in the morning or dropped off at the Front Office. This will help avoid a delay in dismissal and an interruption to your student's class.

Q: What do I do when my student needs to leave early.

Of course, we strongly encourage students to attend a FULL day of school; however, if an emergency occurs and a student must leave early, please email a note for early dismissal first thing in the morning or have your student drop off a note at the Front Office.

This will help avoid a delay in dismissal and not cause an interruption to your student's class.

Q: How do I pick up my student (who does not drive) early?

A: Please come into the front office and sign your student out, please do not call from the car to release your student.

Q: Can I bring my student lunch?

A: No, at this time. to limit the number of guests on campus items (including lunch should not be brought in during the school day.

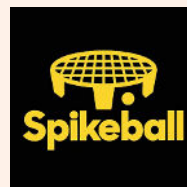
Cardinal Mooney College Fair - Tuesday, March 1, 2022.

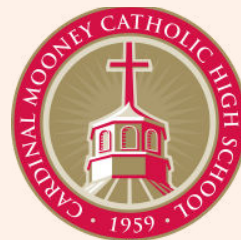
