### from the Dean of Students

#### Q & A with the Dean of Students, Mr. Schenerlein. All about dress codes!

#### Q: What are students supposed to wear on a regular school day?

A: Students have many options with the standardized attire. Students wear a polo with the 'Mooney' logo, available only through CHILDREN'S WORLD.

Students must wear "Docker" style dress pants in khaki tan color with belt loops, and slit pockets only. No jean material. Shirts may be **white**, red or black and Seniors may wear **blue**. Shirts must be tucked in.

Only CMHS sweatshirts may be worn.

#### Q: What does ''Dress-Down/Dress Out'' mean?

A: Dress-Down/Dress Out Days may be announced for special occasions, granted as a privilege, or "sold" for worthy causes by student organizations. Dress Out Days will always be confirmed by the administration and should never be assumed without proper notification. Parameters appropriate to the occasion will be determined and announced by the administration in advance. Students who ignore stated parameters are subject to disciplinary action.

The following rules will ALWAYS apply to any dress-out days:

Leggings are <u>not</u> permitted. Jeans are <u>not</u> to have any rips, tears, or holes. Midriff tops are <u>not</u> allowed. No hats, caps, or sunglasses are allowed indoors.

#### Q: What does ''Jeans Day'' mean?

A: Jeans Days may be granted as a privilege or "sold" for worthy causes by student organizations. Jeans Days will always be confirmed by the administration and should never be assumed without proper notification. On Jeans Days students may wear jeans (substituted for shorts or pants). Jeans may <u>not</u> be frayed, torn, or have holes.

Jean shorts, jean Bermudas or skirts are not permitted.

Unless otherwise announced, all other daily dress code rules apply (CMHS shirts, outerwear, appropriate footwear, etc.).


