

Q & A with the Dean of Students, Mr. Schenerlein

Q: *What can I do to help create a great learning environment for everyone?*

- Student actions should not interfere with teaching or learning in the classroom and will NOT be tolerated.
- Use class time to learn. Do not spend your time talking, listening to music, text-messaging friends, or doing work for other classes.
- Minimize classroom interruptions by arriving to class on time and not leaving during class to visit the bathroom.

Q: *What am I expected to do during the school day?*

- Respect yourself, the teacher & others.
- Respect others' property. Avoid touching or writing on anything that does not belong to you (including desks, textbooks, teacher's belongings, etc.).
- Don't expect that others will clean up your messes. Please pick up after yourself, *including* lunch.
- Respect yourself and the rest of us by using appropriate language.
- Be a kind person.

Cardinal Mooney Catholic High School is committed to promoting a safe, caring, and respectful learning environment for all of its students. As such, bullying, threatening, or harassing behaviors are strictly prohibited and will not be tolerated.

When a student receives notice from a teacher of administrative detention, the student must serve detention within a week of receiving that notification. Students will be sent a message via Canvas from the Dean of Students notifying them of when and where to serve their detentions. **Students are expected to check their Canvas messages daily.**

Administrative detention is held every Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday after school from 2:35 until 3:05. Morning detentions will be offered on Tuesday & Thursday from 7:15 to 7:45 am. Students must arrive on time for detention.

The boys won a huge road match this past week against Tampa Newsome in double OT. The boys travel this week to The East Coast to take on John Carroll and Boca High.


Track & Field
