Q & A with the Dean of Students, Mr. Schenerlein

All about tardiness and absences.

Punctuality is not just about being on time; it is about respecting your commitments.

Q: What time should I be in my class.

A: Students should be seated in their classroom when the bell rings. Coming in when the bell rings is not on time. Walking late with food and beverages shows you had time to arrive earlier.

Q: I can't help that there is traffic; why am I considered late?

A: The administration always pays attention to our local area, and when there is a hold-up, we always give a grace period. However, habitual "it was traffic" is not a valid excuse. Our school doors open at 7 a.m. Start a new routine and plan to arrive 10 minutes earlier, and I guarantee you will be late much less often.

Q: How many absences until...????

A: If you are questioning if you have too many absences, you do. :)

- Excused OR unexcused absences result in <u>too</u> much time lost in the classroom.
- Attending school and arriving on time must be a priority.
- Families should avoid extended vacations that require their children to miss school.
- Try to line up vacations with the school's schedule. The same goes for doctor's appointments.

Absence Reports

Absence reports must be submitted within three days following the absences, notes can be emailed to attendance@cmhs-sarasota.org or turned in to the front office.

The report must come from a parent/guardian or a physician and give the date(s) of the absence and the reason for it.

Parents may be asked to provide written medical documentation when excused absences for illness are excessive.

Boys Lacrosse


