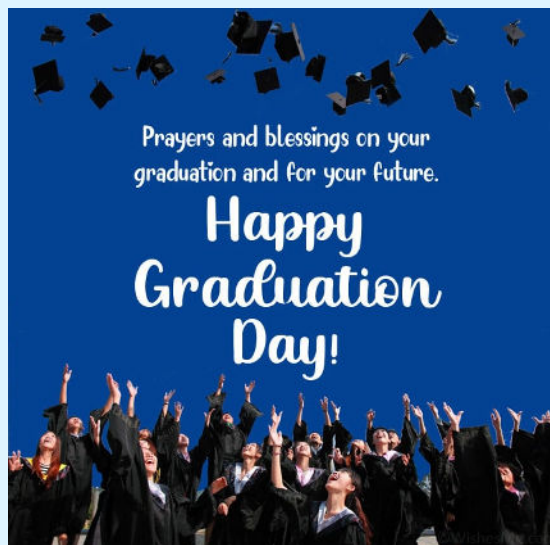
## Senior and Senior Families IMPORTANT INFORMATION
