PARENT COMMUNICATION FLOW CHART

Our goal is to provide our parents, guardians, and students clear guidance on any issue that you may experience in a thorough and prompt manner.

SEEKING THE SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION?

The Diocese of Venice has a religious education office that emphasizes the importance of the Sacrament of Confirmation with a two-year program. The young women and men go through a process where they complete one phase of their faith journey and prepare to begin the next phase as full Christians who are called to be more and reflect the love and goodness Christ in their heart and soul. Parents of a student needing to be confirmed should contact your local home parish to learn more about courses and programs to prepare for Confirmation.

Bishop Dewane has stated that preparation for the reception of Confirmation will be a two-year process, beginning in grade 9, culminating in the reception of the Sacrament at the end of grade 10.

Those desiring Confirmation should be:

- 1. A baptized Catholic who regularly receives Communion.
- 2. Registered in a parish (both preparation for and celebration of the Sacrament will take place in your home parish)
- 3. Be enrolled in the Confirmation Sacramental Preparation program at your parish. It is strongly advised that you contact the Director of Religious Education Office at your parish for registration information and guidelines.
- 4. In the Diocese of Venice in Florida, preparation normally begins in the 9th grade, with the celebration of Confirmation occurring at the end of 10th grade (around the age of 16).


