HOMECOMING 2022 - Information/Dress Code

We are looking forward to our annual Homecoming Dance on Saturday, Oct. 22 from 7:30 pm-10:00 pm on our campus. All CMHS students are invited to attend. (No outside guests will be permitted at this event.) Tickets will go on sale one week before the date and will be sold online & in advance. No tickets will be sold at the door. Stay tuned for more detailed information in the coming weeks.

In the meantime, we know that our students are getting prepared and planning their outfits for the evening. We look forward to seeing our students out of their usual school uniforms and in their semi-formal attire for this special occasion. When choosing an outfit, modesty and appropriate fit must be of primary concern. We have listed some guidelines below to assist in your sound decision-making.

Semi-Formal Dance Dress Code

Gentlemen: Semi-formal Should be appropriately dressy (semi-formal or formal).

- Button-down, collared shirt (short or long sleeve)
- Dress slacks and tie
- No jeans or t-shirts
- Jackets are not required
- No flip-flops

Ladies: Semi-formal

Should be appropriately dressy (semi-formal or formal).

- Hemlines should be longer than the lady's fingertips when her arm is extended by her side.
- Dress slits should begin lower than the fingertips.
- No shorts, bare midriff, low cut back (no lower than natural waistline), slip dresses or rompers.
- No flip-flops
- No strapless dresses and no plunging necklines
- Undergarments should not be visible or see-thru dresses

NOTE: Spaghetti Straps and sleeved off-the-shoulder dresses are permitted.

Dresses may be pre-approved by Mrs. Santiago (<u>JuSantiago@cmhs-sarasota.org</u>) or Mrs. Mercurio (KMercurio@cmhs-sarasota.org) prior to purchase if there are any concerns. Bring or email a picture of the dress and they will let you know if it falls within our guidelines.

A student who does not adhere to these guidelines will not be permitted to enter the dance. All school dress code rules apply in addition to the dance guidelines.
