





BOYS SOCCER: The Cougars are off to a fast start early in the season. The boys have four wins –one loss and one tie. The Cougars defeated Sarasota Christian and Sarasota Military Academy outscoring both teams 15-1 in those two games. Leading the way for the Cougars is sophomore Mark Yencik with 5 goals and senior Lucas Hassler right behind Mark with 4 goals. The team is super balanced with 8 Cougars scoring so far on the season. The boys next play @ Seffner Christian on December 15th away 4pm.



GIRLS SOCCER: The girls soccer team are also off to a great start in the first half of the season. The team has four wins, two loses and one tie. The Cougars have scored 31 goals in just 7 games thus far with senior Gabrielle Joyce leading the way with 8 goals. Ten Cougars have scored so far on the season. The next match is home this Thursday vs. Parrish Community School at 6pm.

GIRLS BASKETBALL: The Cougars have won all five games on the season so far! The girls defeated larger schools St. Pete Lakewood and Tampa Bay Tech last week. Leading the way for the Cougars are Senior Olivia Davis with 19 points a game and Sophomore Kali Barrett with 17 points a game. The next game for the girls is Friday, at Seffner Christian 6pm.

They play their next home game Thursday, December 8th vs. Lakewood Ranch 7pm. Through 5 games Junior Kevin O'Donoghue leads the Cougars with a 16.5 points a game average.
