



WHAT IS BOYS STATE?

Boys State is a unique, one-week, summertime educational program for rising seniors that focuses on participation and personal experience in a model state, complete with governmental bodies and elected public officials. It is designed to mirror the structure and operation of Florida's state government, while providing hands-on training in practical citizenship, leadership and character development through a non-partisan perspective.

THE COOLIDGE SCHOLARSHIP IS NOW OPEN AND ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS.

The Coolidge Scholarship is an annually awarded, full-ride, presidential scholarship that covers a student's tuition, room, board, and expenses for four years of undergraduate study. This scholarship is open to high school students who are residents of Sarasota, Manatee, DeSoto, or Charlotte counties. This scholarship requires a report card and either the guardian's W9, the guardian's 1040 Tax Return, or the student's Proof of Free or Reduced Lunch.
