ASH WEDNESDAY LITURGY & THE BEGINNING OF THE LENTEN SEASON:

Wednesday, February 22, 2023, we will have our All School Ash Wednesday Liturgy.

What is Ash Wednesday? Ash Wednesday is the start of the Lenten season leading up to Easter when Jesus was resurrected. During this period, Christians show repentance and mourning for their sins, because they believe Christ died for them. We recoeve ashes during mass to symbolize both death and repentance.

When and What is Fasting? February 22, 2023, and Good Friday, April 7, 2023, are two days of fasting and abstinence. However, all Fridays of Lent are also days of abstinence from meat. Fasting is to be observed by all Catholics between the ages of 18 years and 59 years. On a fast day, one full meal is allowed or two smaller meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids are allowed.

If possible, the fast on Good Friday is to continue until the Easter Vigil (on Holy Saturday night) as the "paschal fast" to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus and to prepare ourselves to share more fully and to celebrate more readily His Resurrection.

Note: If a person is unable to observe the above regulations due to ill health or other serious reasons, they are urged to practice other forms of self-denial that are suitable to their condition.


Fasting, almsgiving, and prayer are the three traditional disciplines of Lent. The faithful and catechumens should undertake these practices seriously in a spirit of penance and of preparation for baptism or of renewal of baptism at Easter.

Mary Fran Carroll Scholarship


