


LENT...Expanding our prayer life during these next 40 days by turning to the saints

March 3 – The Feast Day of St. Katharine Drexel

- Born in 1858 in Philadelphia to a wealthy family
- Moved by the plight, poor treatment of, and prejudice against Native and African Americans, she was encouraged to become a missionary to these peoples.
- She began the Sisters of the Blessed Sacrament for Indians and Blacks.
- She established a system of black Catholic schools in more than 13 states, 40 mission centers, and 23 rural schools.
- Established 50 missions for Indians in 16 states.
- Died on March 3, 1955, at the age of 96, and was canonized in 2000 by Pope St. John Paul II.
- Second canonized American-born Saint and is the Patron Saint of racial justice and philanthropists.





BOYS LACROSSE




