As a requirement to join AP Spanish level class, students **must successfully** complete a Summer Project by August 11th. For this Summer Project, students will watch short videos, take notes, and must answer comprehension questions about it. Students receive immediate feedback/grade at the end of the video.

Students will now access their summer 2023 assignments directly through the EdPuzzle website.

**Please follow the summer work instructions below:**

**Step 1:** Go to <https://edpuzzle.com/join/enfides> and log in. If it is your first time using Edpuzzle, you need to sign up for an account (no email required!). [www.edpuzzle.com](http://www.edpuzzle.com)

**Step 2:** Enter the class code: **enfides**

**Step 3:** Explore the class and complete assignments!

Please note: videos will not be available until their start date.

### **Instructions:**

- Watch the videos and answer the questions that pop up while you watch.
- Students are responsible for writing any notes you may need from each of the videos. You are also responsible for seeking out more online instructional explanations on any concept presented in each video as that is part of expectations for honors students.
- If a student **scores below 90%** after watching a video and answering its comprehension questions, we encourage him/her to do a re-do to achieve a better grade, therefore a better understating. If you would like to retake one an Edpuzzle assignment, we will reset it for you, but you have to e-mail us evidence that you have done the required extra search & study on your own first. An example of evidence would be a photo of your handwritten notes in your notebook/binder from the extra sources you found online. Please make sure to include the names of the websites or links of the sources you used in your e-mail to us. If after this you still don't understand, feel free to **email me mmasters@cmhs-sarasota.org** to set up a video conference and I'll do my best to explain this concept to you.
