Cardinal Mooney Catholic High School iPad Program 2024-2025

New students will receive the latest iPad with protective keyboard case, charging block, and cord. The iPad comes with an AppleCare Plus 4-year warranty. Students will also have access to technical support from Cardinal Mooney IT staff, proactive system management, pre-loaded apps, and loaner privileges if the iPad becomes inoperable.

<u>Who owns the iPad?</u> Cardinal Mooney owns all iPad equipment and accessories. If a student leaves the school at any time, for any reason, the iPad, protective keyboard case, charging block, and cord must be returned undamaged and in working condition.

<u>Graduation:</u> Seniors who graduate from Cardinal Mooney in good financial standing will be gifted their assigned iPad and accessories.

<u>Maintenance</u>: School iPads require a U.S. Apple ID, prior to orientation. Monitor apps and photos to insure there is at least 6 GB of available space for software updates. Delete all unwanted and unnecessary material regularly. The iPad needs to be charged at home daily. Students are responsible for making sure the device is ready to use during school. Occasionally clean the iPad and case. The iPad must remain in a protective cover while being handled.

What if the iPad / accessories become damaged or inoperable? Contact Mrs. Naylor if the assigned iPad, protective cover, or accessories become damaged or inoperable. She will provide repair information and a loaner unit, if necessary. Please refer to ALL SCHOOL in Canvas for updated information on broken iPads.

What if the iPad is lost or stolen? It is the student's responsibility to keep the iPad secure at all times. The AppleCare warranty does not cover lost or stolen iPads. Contact Mrs. Naylor immediately. If the iPad cannot be located, the family will be responsible for replacement cost. Please be aware, *Find my iPad* will only work if the device is on Wi-Fi and location services are operating.

<u>Acceptable Use:</u> The misuse of technology is a disciplinary matter and will be handled as such. Chronic or flagrant mismanagement of an iPad will result in its removal and revoked technology privileges.
