Parents, Guardians, and Students,
The FACTS Family Portal will open for Course Requests at 3:00 p.m. today, Friday, February 9th. The portal will close at midnight on Monday, February 19th. During the past two weeks, CMHS guidance counselors visited Theology classes to introduce the online course request process. Each student received a paper course request form for reference. Re-enrolled students need to submit their course requests during this period, as some courses have limited seats available.

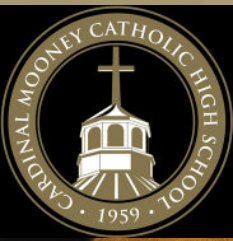

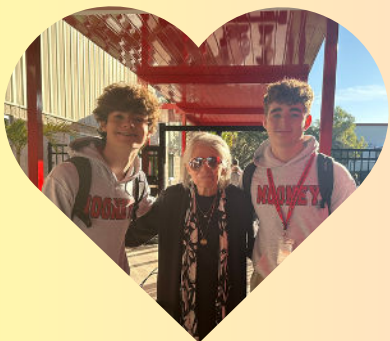

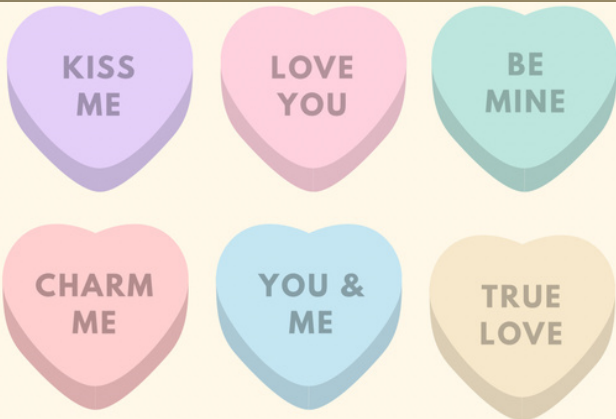

Boys Baseball: Baseball: The Cougars also have their first game next week, facing Sarasota on Monday at 7pm. Pre-season rankings have them projected to be first in their district, giving them something to prove all season long.

Girls Basketball: The ladies are 17-6 and will be hosting the 3A District 11 Championship tonight (2/9) against Bradenton Christian. With a win tonight they will head into regionals with a very high seed. Junior Kali Barret is leading the team, averaging 14 points a game. Sophomore Madi Mignery is leading the team in rebounds, averaging 10.4 rebounds a game, which also makes her the 12th ranked rebounder in the state.

Boys Basketball: The cougars are 16-8 and are entering district play this week. They earned the number one seed in the district playoffs, giving them a first round bye. If they win their semifinal battle against the number four seeded ODA, they will play for the District Championship Saturday, February 10. Senior, Connor Heald, is still leading the team in points averaging 19.7 points per a game. Seniors Carter Jula and Kevin O'Donoghue are both averaging 4.9 rebounds per a game, while Devin Mignery and George Leibold are close behind averaging 3.9 rebounds a game.

Comp Cheer: Our competition cheer team placed 4th in Semi-finals at 7th overall in the State.

Girls Weightlifting: The girls weightlifting had a successful run at the Regional Championships. Shelly DiLorenzo, Zoe Kirby and Valentina Rue will be moving onto States next weekend Lakeland, Fl.

Boys Lacrosse: The boys lacrosse team kicks off their season this weekend at the Lax Against Leukemia preseason tournament. Next week, they host their first regular season game on Thursday against Steinbrenner.

Girls Lacrosse: The girls lacrosse team will also be competing in Lax Against Leukemia. Next week, they travel to Academy of the Holy Names on Monday, and Lakewood Ranch High School on Tuesday to kick off their season.
