

Dear Students and Families,



Girls Basketball: Our girls basketball team won in the state semifinals on Wednesday 66-52. They are headed to the STATE CHAMPIONSHIP tonight at 5:30 in Lakeland, against Miami Country Day. Junior Symonique Simons and freshman Madi Mignery each scored 17 points in the final four game. Madi Mignery also had 21 rebounds. Let's cheer on our ladies as they head to Lakeland to bring back a state title.

Boys lacrosse: The boys lacrosse team is currently 3-1 on the season. They lost a close one last week to Plant, but have won their last two games. They beat Viera last Friday 13-9 and Newsome on Tuesday night 11-7. They have a busy week next week, taking on Lakewood Ranch and Berkeley Prep at home Monday and Tuesday. Friday (March 8) they travel to Lake Mary. Senior goalie Jacob Brown (captain) has had an impressive season thus far, averaging an over 60% save percentage.

Girls lacrosse: The girls lacrosse team is currently 1-4. They had a big win against Venice Monday night, winning 19-8.
