



Girls Lacrosse: The girls lacrosse team is 7-7 on the season and starts district playoffs this week. They face Bradenton Christian in their first playoff game. Senior Morgan Costallos leads the team, averaging 4.6 goals a game.

Boys Lacrosse: The cougars are 11-5 overall on the season, and are entering into district play. They have a first round bye and will face the winner of Bradenton Christian vs St Pete Catholic on Tuesday 4/16. Senior goalie Jacob Brown is averaging a nearly 70% save percentage.

Baseball: The cougars baseball team is 9-7-1, racking up two wins over spring break. They face Bishop Verot at home on Saturday (4/13) at 2pm. Junior Eddie Zaun leads the team in both batting average and on base percentage. Sophomore Mateu Dalmau leads the team with 18 runs.

Softball: The softball team is 11-3 and is on an impressive 6 game winning streak. They have a home game Tuesday 4/16 against Bayshore at 4pm. Senior Madison Duncan has 30 runs this season, and has the highest batting percentage at 0.989.

Beach Volleyball: The cougars are 11-2 after defeating both Parish and Clearwater Central Catholic last week. They travel to Bradenton Christian and Venice next week to fini





