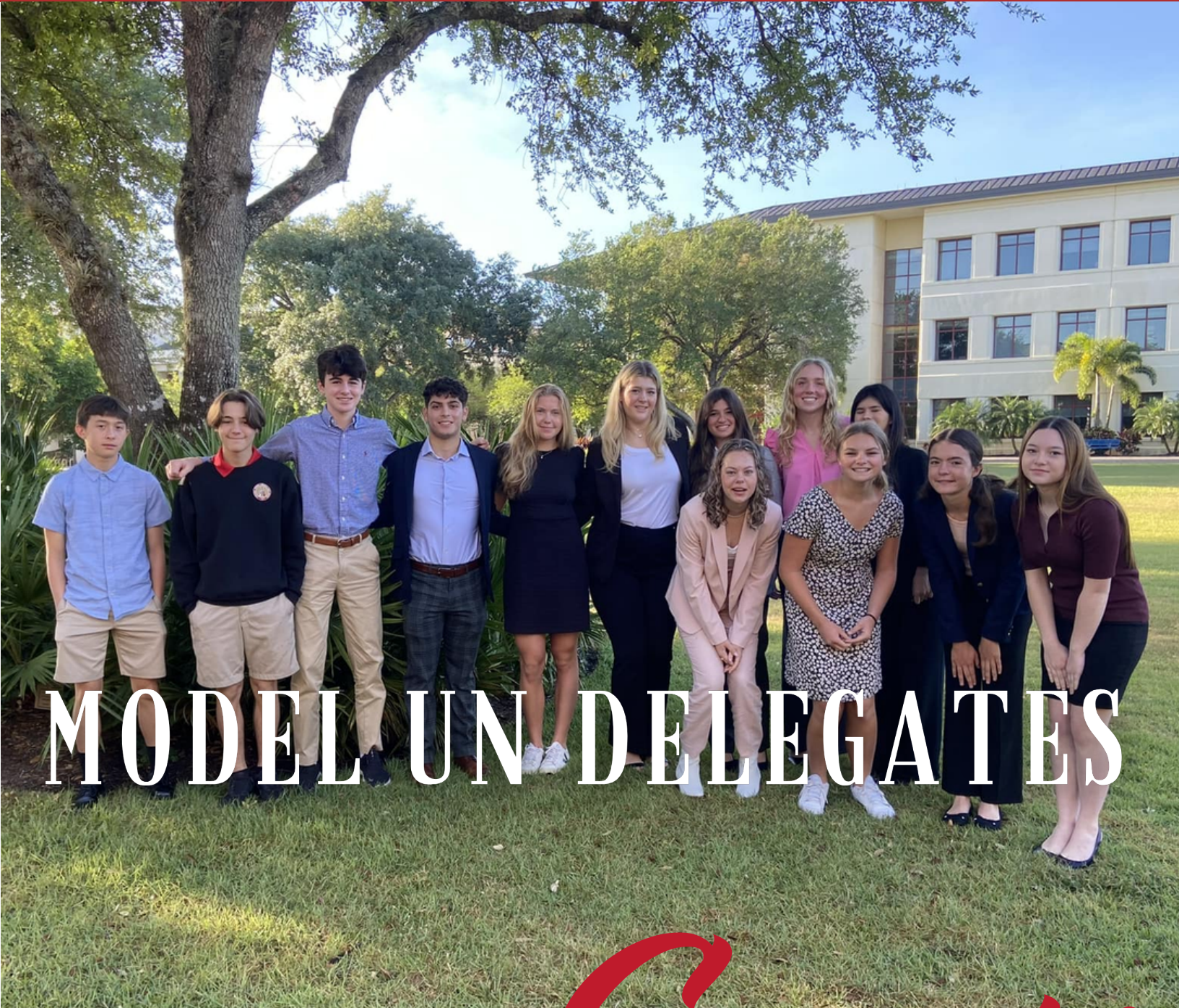

## **Yearbook Editors**

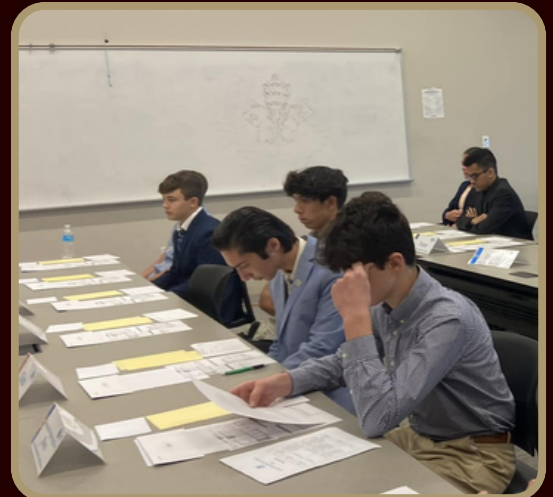

**Boys lacrosse:** The boys lacrosse team is 12-5 and they face ODA in the district championship (4/18), and continue playoffs next week. Senior goalie Jacob Brown has over a 60% save percentage this season. Three seniors: Giovanni Zanoni, John Twilley, and Drew Roberts were all nominated for the Tampa Lax Report Senior All Star Game.

**Baseball:** The Cougars are 10-8-1 on the season and they celebrated Senior Night on Tuesday. They travel to St Pete Catholic tonight (4/19) and host North Port on Tuesday, 4/23, at 4:30pm. 
