### **2024/25 DRESS CODE**

Dear Cardinal Mooney Community,

CMHS has been in the process of phasing out hoodies, gray polo's and other clothing options as part of the dress code. This decision was driven by the need to reassess our school's dress code policy to ensure consistency and professionalism for our students.

In the past, CMHS has allowed many types of clothing and outerwear and it has become increasingly difficult to manage. The school understands that many of those options such as hoodies can be popular among students and parents. It is important to remember that the enforcement of the updated dress code policy is crucial.

Starting with the 2024-25 school, CMHS dress code will ONLY include......

- Red, white, black & blue senior polo's (with cougar head logo)
- Red & black quarter zip pullovers (academic & cougar head logo)
- Red & black crew neck sweatshirts (academic & cougar head logo)

All of these options are available through Children's World, our exclusive school outfitter.

Many of the sports teams and clubs sell clothing with vendors outside of Children's World. These clothing articles will not be part of the daily dress code. Children's World does provide options for students to represent their team or club on the polo's, quarter zips and crewnecks. Students will have the opportunity to wear hoodies and other school spirit clothing as a part of "Spirit Days", "Dress down Days" and certain game days. This allows for a balance between the dress code and providing students with opportunities to showcase their team or club spirit.

### It's Time to **Renew or Apply** for your Step Up Scholarship!

It's time to log into your Step Up EMA Dashboard and renew or apply for your Step Up Scholarship for the 2024-2025 school year. Please note that all students regardless of income, will receive the state scholarship. In early June, I will be sending out the 2024-2025 Parent Agreement for Step Up. Please ensure that you fill out this agreement promptly and email back to me. (PLEASE DO NOT EMAIL YOUR AWARD # AT THIS TIME. All enrollment for Step Up will be done with the Parent Agreement.)

Additionally, In July, the State will be releasing the new award amounts by county for the 2024-2025 school year. Once we have this information, the Business Office will deduct the total award from your tuition. You will receive an email notification when your Step Up Award has been deducted from FACTS tuition, along with a new payment amount.


