Our Spanish program integrates grammar in isolation, grammar in context and communicative skills. Our students learn concepts and need to be able to recognize them and apply them while communicating in Spanish (written and/or oral).

These are the main grammar, vocabulary and culture topics covered in class from Spanish I to Honors Spanish III. This file also has links for explanations, practice and feedback.

- ALL present indicative (regulares, irregulares, progresivo, "boot verbs", "gustar", near future =ir +a +infinitivo, near past=acabar de infinitivo, ser vs estar, yo-go verbs= 1st person irregular, tener, tener que)
- adjetivos calificativos, adjetivos posesivos , telling time, prepositions, comparative and superlative, "hace +time expressions"
- Weather expressions
- Personal "A"
- Pretérito (regulares e irregulares)
